RE: Kansas State University Scholarship Opportunity

Dear Sir or Madam:

My name is David Marty, Director of Operations for The Mennel Milling Company headquartered in Fostoria, Ohio. The Mennel Milling Company is a privately held family company which has been in the wheat flour milling industry for 125 years. Today, Mennel is an industry-leading producer of high-quality flours to many customers throughout the food industry. At present, the company operates five flour mills and five country grain elevators located within Ohio, Virginia, Illinois, Indiana and Michigan.

The purpose of contacting you today is to share with you that The Mennel Milling Company has recently created a new scholarship opportunity for eligible students in your respective area and ask for your assistance in communicating this information to your students, club members and / or community.

In an effort to support our local communities, while strengthening our industry and the Grain Science program at Kansas State University, Mennel has developed a scholarship to study Milling Science / Operations at Kansas State University, <http://www.grains.ksu.edu>.

This scholarship is open to non-Kansas residents who reside in the county and adjacent counties in which Mennel has operating locations. It will allow non-residents to study for the same cost as an in-state, Kansas resident. For example, current out-of-state tuition is approximately \$15,800 annually, vs. \$5,800 annually for in-state tuition. Mennel's scholarship award will cover this difference (an approximate \$10,000/yr value.) In addition, Mennel's scholarship will provide for an additional \$1,000 per year to cover student travel expenses for approximately \$11,000 in total scholarship award value.

The details of this exciting opportunity, including eligibility requirements, application procedures and selection criteria are included herein.
