

HONORARY STATE FFA DEGREE OFFICIAL NOMINATION FORM

The Honorary Degree Program is operated under policies and procedures approved by the Ohio FFA Board of Trustees and State Officers. Honorary Degrees are provided for in the Ohio FFA Constitution. The Honorary State FFA Degree is the second-highest Honorary Degree, and it is presented by the Ohio FFA Association at the annual State FFA Convention.

PURPOSE: The purpose of the degree program is to recognize individuals who have rendered outstanding service to the agricultural education-FFA program.

CRITERIA OF NOMINATION: Individuals nominated must have provided exceptional (outstanding) service to agriculture and/or the agricultural education/FFA program. Individuals nominated from a chapter must have the approval of the State FFA Executive Secretary. Nominations may also be made by members of the Ohio FFA Board of Trustees, state FFA officers, State Staff, Ohio FFA Foundation Executive Director, Ohio FFA Camp Director, and the coordinator for the Ohio Career Development Events.
